Disc Film 6000

The Kodak disc 6000 was manufactured in USA in 1982-1984 by Eastman Kodak Company. Features of this camera is the close up lens for portraits, and has a door which protects the lens and buttons.

This camera has 12.5mm, f/2.8 Aspheric Lens with a film size was HR Disc Film, with picture size of 8 x 10mm. The disc camera was fixed focus but with a shift in front lens for portrait and landscape, Focus range portrait setting: 0.5-1.2m (1.5-4.0 ft.) landscape setting: 1.2m- infinity (4.0- infinity) Viewfinder optical
The Shutter speed settings were 1/100 and 1/200. Exposure automatic, exposure meter CdS cell.
Small flash built in which fires automatically. The camera also had Film advance and auto winding.
