Polaroid Colorpack 80

The Polaroid Colorpack 80 was a rigid plastic bodied instant camera, made in the UK from 1971-76.

Film type is Peel-apart 80-Series Land Pack Films (3 1/4" x 3 3/8", image=2 3/4" x 2 7/8") such as Polaroid 87, 88, Viva. (All discontinued). It has a Manual focus range from 3 feet to infinity. ISO 75 for colour prints, 3000 for black and white. The Viewfinder contains a red square to show where the head in a portrait should appear. The flash cubes used for this camera is Phillips PFC 4. The shutter requires two standard 1.5V AA batteries. Camera includes neck strap and cold clip.
